Storytelling Training Workshop + 'Share the Joy of Reading' Storytelling Outreach Programme

Featuring a STEAM-related English storybook, this workshop consisted of four immersive training sessions. Our Reading Ambassadors were equipped to narrate this story to primary school pupils and showcased an experiment of neutralization to enhance the storytelling experience during their visit to Buddhist Chan Wing Kan Memorial School on 26 March 2024. This allowed the primary school pupils to actively participate in the experiment, further enriching their engagement with the storytelling session. The experiment involved making a fizzy lemonade, which captivated the pupils as they observed the bubbling reaction. Additionally, the pupils were amazed to see the erupting volcano, sparking their curiosity and enthusiasm for science in a fun and memorable way.



Drama Appreciation - Dialogue between Novel and Drama

Having read the book ‘The Miracles of the Namiya General Store (解憂雜貨店)’, students appreciated the drama adaptation in Kwai Tsing Theatre. Before the show, they shared with each other their understanding of the novel. After the show, they compared and analyzed the differences between novels and plays, integrating their comprehension of both the original novel and the play.



Students' Reflection

Discussion: ‘Before watching the theatrical adaptation of “The Miracles of the Namiya General Store”, what did you expect the play to change from the novel?’

3C Chen Yik Pui: ‘Some scenes in the book, such as the fire, are difficult to portray on stage, so the play may use alternative plotlines or simply not depict them.’

Discussion: ‘Through comparing the novel and the theatrical adaptation, what have you learned?’

6D Leung Yan Yee: ‘In the play, the scenes from the novel need to be presented in reality. Some more fantastical scenes may be challenging to portray, so whether reading the novel or enjoying the play, we need to use our imagination.’

Dr. Poon Po-chiu actively interacted with students, encouraging attentive listening during the talk. 



A Unique Souvenir from YLPSS Library


Book recommendations in morning assemblies
