1. School Vision & Mission

1.1 School Vision

Our school is committed to developing and implementing innovative teaching and learning strategies that maximize students' learning outcomes. Our school aims at nurturing a safe and supportive learning environment that caters for students' individual needs.

1.2 School Mission

Through the creation of a positive and harmonious learning environment, our school is dedicated to educating children in their intellectual, physical, social, moral and aesthetic development.

2. Our School

2.1 School History

Our school was founded in 1946 and was the first government school in the New Territories. From 1949, the campus had been situated in Au Tau. It was then relocated in 1989 to our existing campus on Town Park Road South in Yuen Long. We are a co-educational, Anglo-Chinese government secondary school. Except for Chinese subjects, English is used as the medium of instruction. Our school has upheld simplicity as the essence of our school ethos.

2.2 School Facilities

Apart from standard school facilities, our school facilities include several special rooms: the STEM Centre, the Campus TV Centre, the Multi-Media Language Centre, the Computer-Assisted Learning Room, the English Language Room, the Liberal Studies Learning Room, and the Amenities Centre. All the classrooms and special rooms are equipped with networked computers, multi-media projectors and wireless microphone systems to enhance the effectiveness of learning and teaching. In addition, LCD televisions are installed in the covered playground to broadcast the latest news to students. The school is fully air-conditioned to provide a comfortable and cosy learning environment for students.

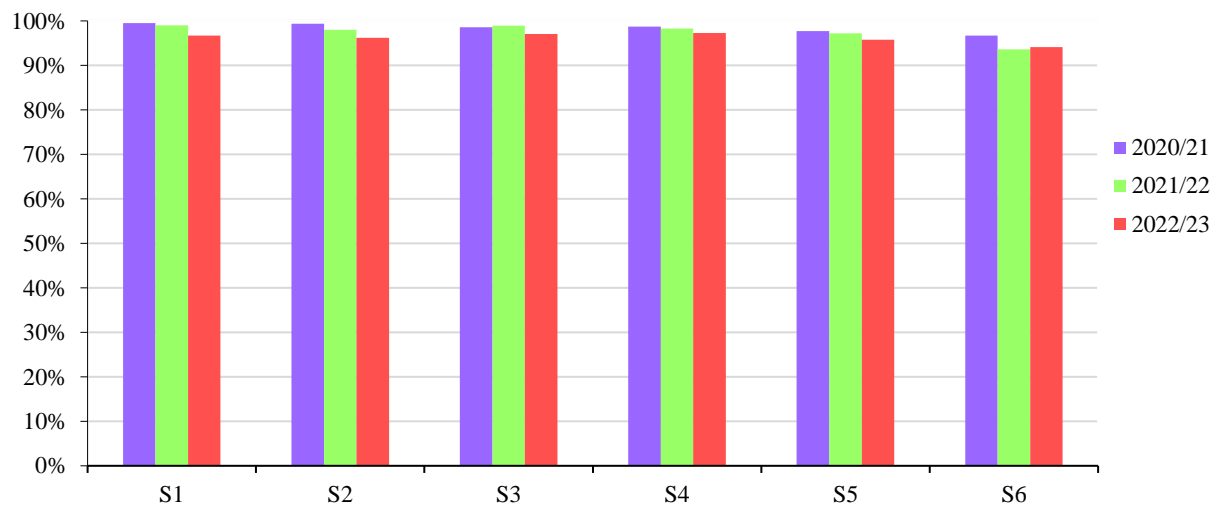

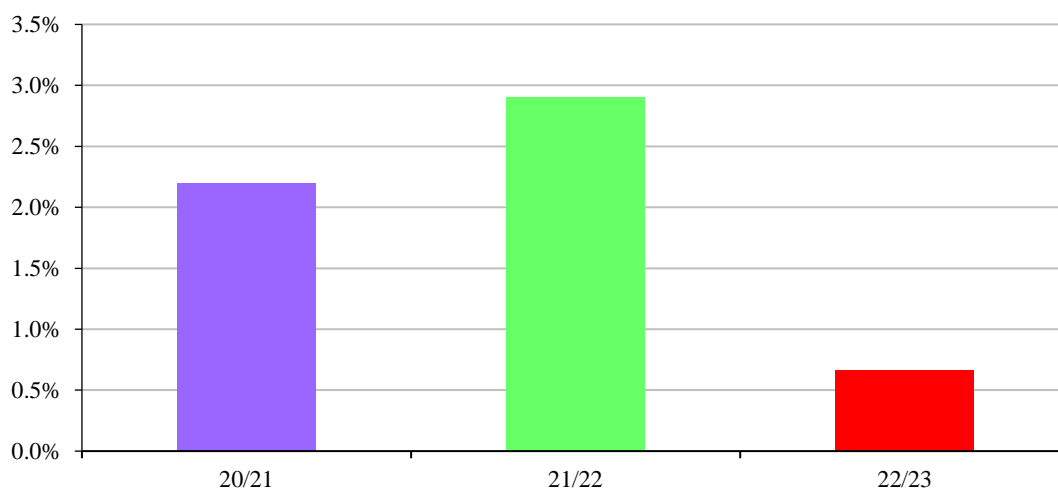

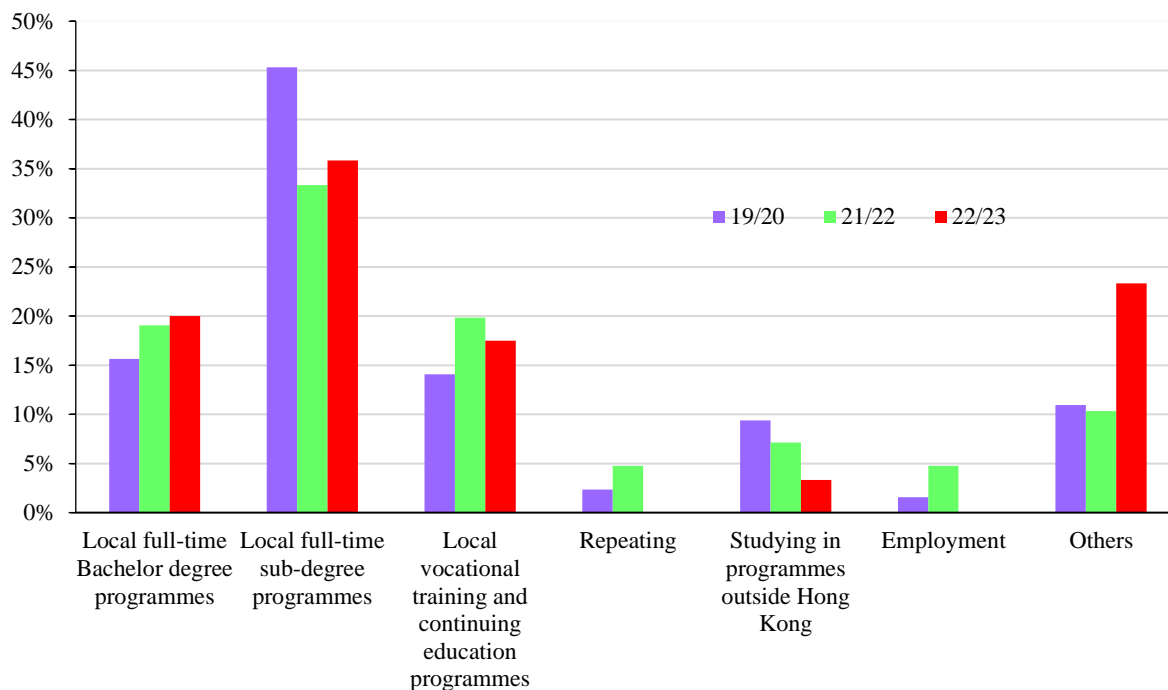
3.2 Student Attendance Rate

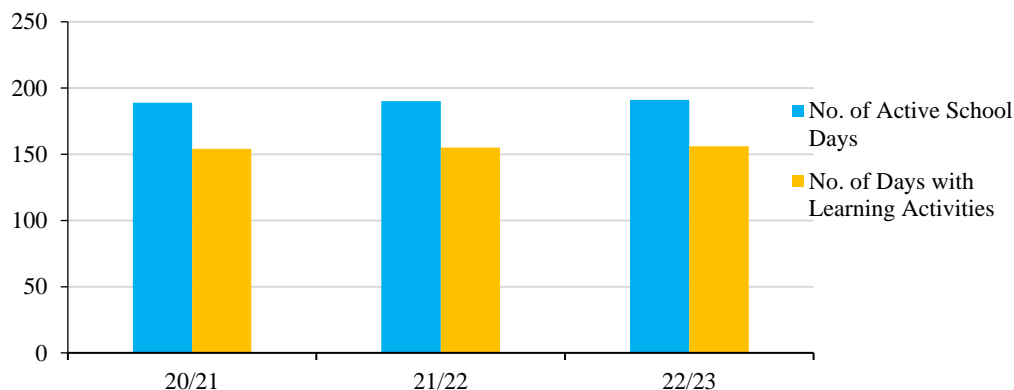
Our teachers attended a total of 3857.4 hours of professional development in various training courses, seminars, and workshops.

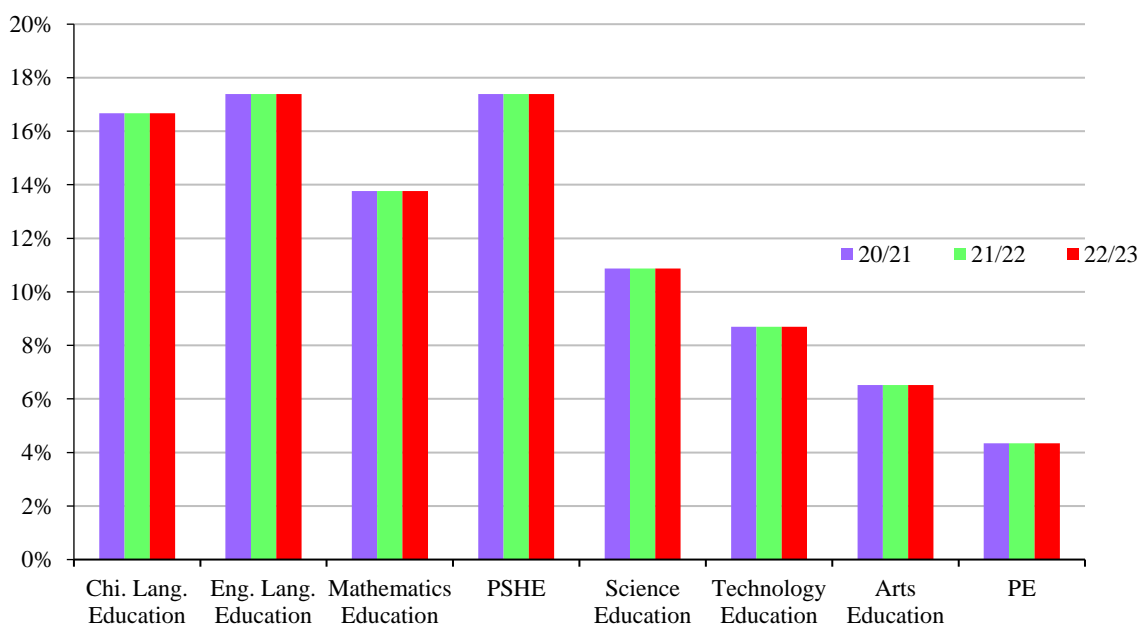

6. Major Concerns

6.1 Learning and Teaching

Objectives Achieved:

1. To provide a more inclusive and learning-friendly environment in terms of class structure, subject alternatives and supplementary support
2. To identify learners' different attributes and differentiate curriculum in order to provide a more suitable and supportive learning environment
3. To modify teaching strategies and learning activities design to support individual students' learning
4. To create opportunities for all to succeed

Evaluation:

1. From the students and teachers' feedback and evaluation, both interim and annual, it is observed that various specialized courses have been conducted for students with different needs, including those from Chinese classes in S1, those who take only 2X in S4 and S5, gifted students, potential level 4 or above students, etc. Some teachers have adopted small group seating arrangement and cooperative learning with positive effect on students' learning. 'My Forte' notice board display has encouraged students to show their own talents and learn to appreciate others'.
2. A learning preference survey was conducted to obtain information about students' individual learning style to help teachers design learning tasks to suit students' needs. Most subjects have reflected they have identified core and optional components in their syllabus, designed tiered/graded learning materials, provided supplementary support for weaker students and more challenging tasks for stronger students.
3. Some recommended teaching strategies have been adopted by teachers of different subjects, such as multi-sensory / multi-modal learning, elearning, group learning and providing students options of the same task. These strategies have been reflected in the design of the learning tasks and some samples have been collected for future reference. Peer lesson observation has been carried out among most teachers with debriefing for improvement.
4. 70% of students agreed that their talents or learning outcomes have been showcased in different platforms for recognition and appreciation. 74% agreed the feedback given by teachers has helped them improve their learning. About 72% agreed that formative assessment methods could help them monitor their learning progress and make further improvement.
5. About 65% of students said that they have set short and long-term goals for themselves and reviewed the goals timely for improvement. Our team believes that students may focus better if we guide them to set simpler and more specific goals. So in the coming year, we will guide students to set one academic and one non-academic goal and invite respective teachers to guide them to do review and evaluation.
6. It was found that peer evaluation and setting assessment criteria / rubrics have not been used widely across different subjects. We believe these routines may help students better understand their areas for improvement and raise their awareness of self-reflection. We will encourage all departments to incorporate these routines in their daily teaching.

6.2 Student Development

Objectives Achieved:

1. To raise students' awareness of the importance of responsibility and to support them to fulfil it
2. To guide students to be committed to their roles
3. To enlighten their understandings of the sense of integrity
4. To assist students to set achievable goals and to strive for them through constant diligence and perseverance

Evaluation:

A student survey and teacher observation were conducted to obtain the following data:

1. 78.6% of students agreed that they have successfully set their attainable goal and worked hard to achieve it. The goal setting programme was presented clearly and guided students in a systematic way to complete their targets.
2. According to the survey, students agreed that they have a better understanding about the five core values through formal curriculum and diversified thematic activities. 80.3% of students stated that the positive values helped them to solve difficulties when they face challenges. Among the five values, most students stated that they have built up a better sense of responsibility.
3. 81.3% of students pointed out that our school has adopted an all means approach to showcase students' achievements and learning experiences so as to recognise their good practices.
4. The majority of teachers agreed diversified school-based activities and student leader posts could provide students with opportunities to apply and consolidate their knowledge about positive values and attitudes.

Although the majority of students expressed that various learning activities, student leader duties and competitions could enrich their sense of positive values, we believe that all school parties should continue creating opportunities for students to apply and strengthen the core values so as to better prepare them to face different challenges in the future.

From the survey, both teachers and students pointed out that it is beneficial to share more stories of successful role models with students and cultivate an international vision in students so that students will have the ability to view problems from different perspectives and make sensible judgments in different issues.

Another issue worth noticing is that some students showed willingness to participate in more activities, whilst teachers' feedback has shown that there were difficulties in finding time and venues for activities under the packed teaching schedule. In that case, teachers could explore chances to collaborate with different subjects to embed activities in formal curriculum or organize them during KLA days.

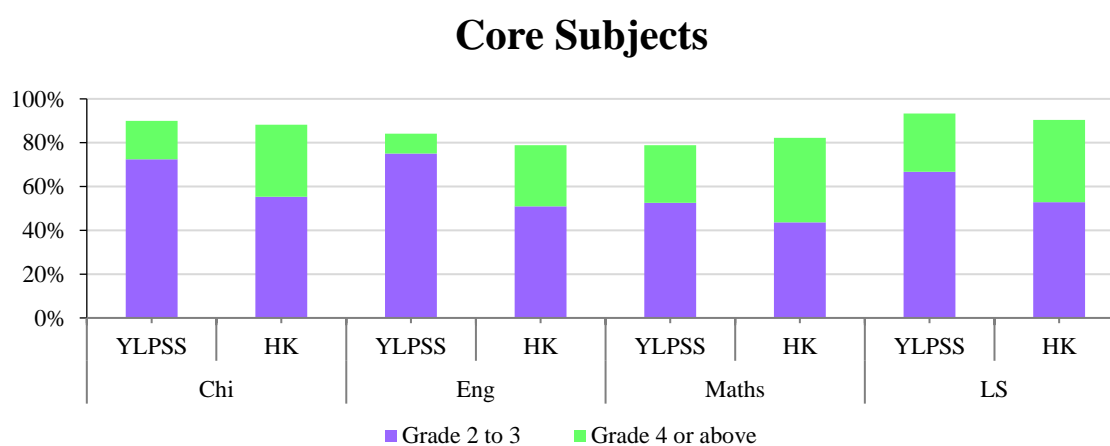

2. To promote Values Education through nurturing in students the ten priority values and attitudes.
