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1. School Vision & Mission

1.1 School Vision

Our school is committed to developing and implementing innovative teaching and learning strategies that maximize students' learning outcomes. Our school aims at nurturing a safe and supportive learning environment that caters for students' individual needs.

1.2 School Mission

Through the creation of a positive and harmonious learning environment, our school is dedicated to educating children in their intellectual, physical, social, moral and aesthetic development.

2. Our School

2.1 <u>School History</u>

Our school was founded in 1946 and was the first government school in the New Territories. From 1949, the campus had been situated in Au Tau. It was then relocated in 1989 to our existing campus on Town Park Road South in Yuen Long. We are a co-educational, Anglo-Chinese government secondary school. English is used as the medium of instruction in most classes. There are two Chinese classes in S1 and S2 respectively in which English, Mathematics and Science are taught in English, hoping to accommodate the diverse learning needs of students. Our school has upheld simplicity as the essence of our school ethos.

2.2 School Facilities

Apart from standard school facilities, our school facilities include several special rooms: the STEM Centre, the Campus TV Centre, the Multi-Media Language Centre, the Computer-Assisted Learning Room, the English Language Room, the Liberal Studies Learning Room, and the Amenities Centre. All the classrooms and special rooms are equipped with networked computers, multi-media projectors and wireless microphone systems to enhance the effectiveness of learning and teaching. In addition, LCD televisions are installed in the covered playground to broadcast the latest news to students. The school is fully air-conditioned to provide a comfortable and cosy learning environment for students.






3.2 Student Attendance Rate


Teacher Professional Development

Our teachers attended a total of 3448.33 hours of professional development in various training courses, seminars, and workshops.



6. Major Concerns

6.1 Learning and Teaching

Objectives:

- 1. To provide a more inclusive and learning-friendly environment in terms of class structure, subject alternatives and supplementary support
- 2. To identify learners' different attributes and differentiate curriculum in order to provide a more suitable and supportive learning environment
- 3. To modify teaching strategies and learning activities design to support individual students' learning
- 4. To create opportunities for all to succeed

Achievements

- 1. Students' awareness about their individual strengths and weaknesses was raised. They had a clearer idea of their own learning style through the learning preference survey and could adopt more suitable learning approaches for themselves. Over 80% of target students with different abilities were offered specialized classes or courses to suit their learning needs, and they reflected positively on these learning arrangements. Students set both academic and non-academic goals as their targets and displayed their talents through various platforms.
- 2. All teachers explored and adopted Learner Diversity (LD) teaching strategies to help students learn to their best abilities. They designed graded learning materials and carried out collaborative lesson planning and peer lesson observation to brainstorm LD teaching ideas and share good practices among colleagues. Some outstanding teaching ideas were shared during panel meetings, staff meetings and staff development days.

Reflection

Both students and teachers worked together to embrace learner diversity. Various LD strategies have been tried out and students have shown their feedback on different measures. With students' and teachers' feedback collected, all subject departments are going to focus on two specific LD teaching strategies and evaluate the effectiveness of them more closely in the coming school year.

Feedback and Follow-up

- 1. The adoption of online Goal Setting was not carried out as smoothly as expected due to technical issues and time constraints during class teacher periods. Therefore, the printed version of Goal Setting is suggested to be used for quicker administration and easier follow-up.
- 2. Only 60% of students agreed that they had chances to showcase their talents on different platforms. Some students might not have noticed their works have been displayed, but we will continue to encourage teachers to create opportunities and channels for students to display their strengths and learning outcomes.
- 3. To help students better understand their achievements and areas for improvement, we highly recommend that teachers make use of success criteria or assessment rubrics which can now be generated with the help of AI.

6.2 <u>Student Development</u>

Objectives:

- 1. To build up students' respectful mind
- 2. To develop students' empathy
- 3. To foster the spirit of caring and helping others

Achievements

- 1. In collaboration with the Whole Person Development Team and the Major Concern 1 Academic Domain Team, students set goals through pledge 2.0 online and class teachers regularly reviewed progress throughout the year.
- 2. With guidance from a range of organized activities, including talks, workshops during GAP (Guided Activity Periods), service learning visits, and outings, students were able to gain deeper self-awareness and understanding. Based on both teacher observations and student surveys, the structured programs have helped students develop crucial insights. Students now have a better understanding of the importance of caring for others and being more considerate in their interactions. Teachers have observed students demonstrating more respectful behaviors towards the feelings, opinions, and property of their peers. Furthermore, the numbers of students volunteering for school duties, uniform groups, and the service learning team have been steadily increasing. Through the voluntary service initiatives coordinated by the Service Learning Team, many students have been able to earn notable awards and recognition within the local community and even at the territorial level.

- 3. In this academic year, students were provided with numerous opportunities to expand their worldviews and gain a deeper understanding of individuals from diverse life backgrounds. These learning experiences were facilitated through both the formal curriculum and various school-organized activities, including cultural exchange trips to China, Thailand, and Korea, visits to the elderly organized by Suicide Prevention Services and participation in the "Dialogue in the Dark" program.
- 4. More than 70% of parents expressed that our school successfully fostered a loving and caring atmosphere for the students. Over 80% of parents stated that their children were learning within a harmonious school environment, which enabled them to develop essential values to use for their lifetime.

Reflection

- 1. According to the student survey, there were a few reports suggesting that unwise use of the Internet has led to a lack of mutual respect among students.
- 2. Despite the diverse array of activities and services provided to students throughout the school year, a small percentage of students reported that they did not actively participate in these offerings.
- 3. The number of voluntary service hours completed by students was commendable, thus, the school should explore ways to encourage greater student participation in order to expand the opportunity for more students to earn recognition and awards.

Feedback and Follow-up

- 1. As there are concerns about some students not using the Internet information wisely, to foster a safe and respectful school community, the school would provide students with comprehensive guidance and resources on using IT ethically and effectively, so as to empower them as responsible digital citizens and lifelong learners.
- 2. The school should diversify the range of activities and services to a broader spectrum of student interests and learning preferences. It is important to give students an explicit and clear message about the objectives and intended outcomes of the activity or service so as to help students understand the purpose and potential benefits, thereby increasing their motivation to participate actively. It is also essential to implement structured debriefing sessions following the completion of activities and services as it could provide a platform for students to express their opinions, share their experiences, and provide feedback.
- 3. All teams and departments could further explore opportunities to incorporate service-learning components into relevant academic courses or programmes. This would allow students to apply their classroom knowledge to real-world community issues.


