# Moral and Civic Education Week

In order to help students develop a better understanding of positive values and well-equip them with the skills and knowledge necessary to become responsible and active citizens to face their future challenges, the Moral and National Education Team, Parents-Teachers Association, English Department, Reading Promotional Team and Library and Campus TV has jointly organised the Moral and Civic Education Week from March 20th to March 24th, 2023 to promote and foster students' positive values and attitudes.

Throughout the week, a range of activities were organized to encourage students to reflect on positive values and promote civic responsibilities. One of the highlights of the week was the Positive Value Slogan Design Competition. S.1 to S.5 students were invited to come up with creative and meaningful slogans that promotes the five major positive values of the year. They are 'Responsibility', 'Commitment', 'Integrity', 'Diligence' and 'Perseverance' respectively. The competition was a great success, with many creative and inspiring entries submitted. The winning slogans were displayed around the school and are planned to be made into bookmarks to be distributed to all students.



In addition to the Slogan Design Competition, the school also organized a Film Appreciation. The award-winning movie 'Zero to Hero' was selected to explore the moral and civic themes. The film is based on the true story of medal-winning Paralympian So Wa Wai, who overcame personal and physical struggles with the help of his mother to emerge a winner. During the film showing session, we were honored to have the support from the school Parents-Teachers Association to provide students with unlimited amount of popcorn. The movie was a great choice for students to understand the importance of perseverance and realize that with continued efforts they will be able to achieve their goals despite difficulties, failures or opposition. It also offers an opportunity for students to engage themselves with complex issues and develop their critical thinking skills.

The week also featured a board display with the five major positive values and attitudes of the year and a variety of



interactive game stalls organized by the Moral and National Education Team and English Society in the school covered playground and at the main entrance. Students were given with game cards and encouraged to participate in the games and read the messages conveyed on the specially designed positive values posters.

One of the most inspiring events of the week was the talk 'Let's meet our outstanding alumnus'. A former student of our school, Dr Abraham Lam, shared his experiences and insights on his courage in the face of his adversities and how he succeeded in starting up his own business. His story and advice served as powerful evidence to teach, inspire and influence our students.



A wide range of learning and teaching activities of various Key Learning Areas and relevant learning experiences were also arranged during the week to deepen students' understandings of the positive values. 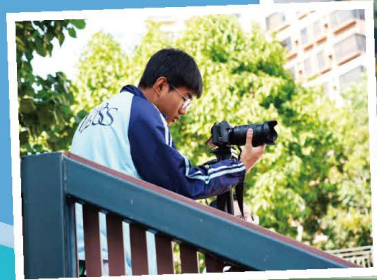

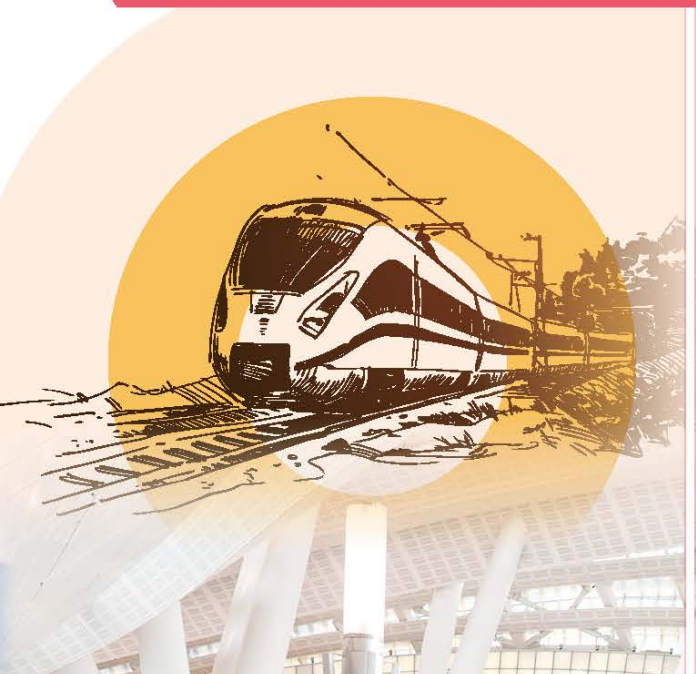




# 中五級公民與社會發展科內地考察團

## 「穿梭十八區一撫今追昔日社區推廣計劃」

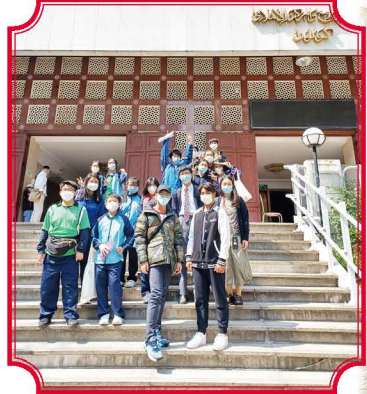
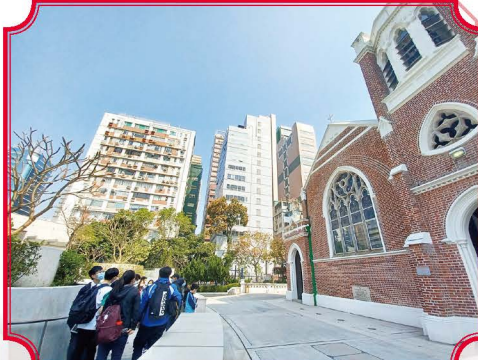
