a. The Half-yearly Examination and S6 Mock Examination

1. The Half-yearly Examination (HYE) (S1-S5) and S6 Mock Examination are scheduled from 6.1.2022 (Thursday) to 21.1.2022 (Friday).
2. Please refer to the attachments for “Regulations for Examinations” and “Examination Timetables”. The examination timetables will be uploaded to the school website for parents’ and students’ reference.
3. The examination content for S1 to S5 will be uploaded on 10.12.2021 (Friday) to eClass (<http://eclass.ylpss.edu.hk/home/index.php>)

4. Students must attend the examinations according to the examination timetables; they are not required to return to school on the days they have no examination.
5. If parents need to pick up their child, please pay attention to each examination time.
6. S1-S5 1st term final score of each subject is calculated on the following basis:
 $1^{\text{st}} \text{ term final score of each subject} = 0.8 * \text{HYE score} + 0.2 * (1^{\text{st}} \text{ UT score \& daily assessment})$
S6 annual score of each subject is calculated on the following basis:
 $S6 \text{ annual score of each subject} = 0.8 * \text{ME score} + 0.2 * (1^{\text{st}} \text{ UT score \& daily assessment})$
7. S1-S5 annual average score of each subject is calculated on the following basis:
 $\text{The annual average score of each subject} = 0.4 * \text{HYE score} + 0.6 * \text{YE score}$
8. Examination paper discussion will be conducted from 24.1.2022 (Monday) to 26.1.2022 (Wednesday).
9. 18.2.2022 (Friday) would be S6 last school day.
10. S6 students may collect their mock examination report sheet and “My Learning Progress” from the General Office between 28.2.2022 (Monday) to 30.3.2022 (Wednesday) during office hours.
11. The Graduation Ceremony will be held on 30.6.2022 (Thursday). Parents will be informed of the details in due course.
12. S6 students need to come to school to collect their HKDSE result slips on 20.7.2021 (Wednesday) at 8:30 a.m..

b. Regulations for Examinations

1. If the Education Bureau announces the suspension of schools due to adverse weather conditions, such as tropical cyclone, heavy rainstorm, or any other reasons, the examinations on that day will be postponed. The subsequent examination timetable will remain unchanged. 22.1.2022 (Saturday) is reserved for the above postponement if necessary.
2. Students are advised to arrive at the Examination Centre at least **15 minutes before** the commencement of an examination. Students who arrive after the start of the examination will be regarded as latecomers and subject to **a conduct mark penalty**.
3. In normal circumstances, students who arrive 30 minutes after the start of the examination may not be permitted to sit for the examination. Latecomers will not be given extra time.
4. In no circumstances will the school arrange another examination for absentees. Absentees without pre-approved or acceptable reasons will receive zero marks for the paper from which they are absent. An assessed mark will be given in the following situations:
 - (i) Students are absent due to sickness supported by **a doctor's medical certificate**;
 - (ii) Students are caught in unexpected situations proven by **certified documents** or **approved by the school**.

This assessed mark is calculated based on the student's performance in their tests and daily homework. The final examination mark for the missed paper will be 70% of the assessed mark.
5. For English Speaking Examination, students should pay attention to each examination time and be punctual for the examination.
6. After entering the Examination Centre, students should take their pre-assigned seats or seats assigned by the invigilators.
7. In the Examination Centre, students should remain silent at all times and follow the instructions given by the invigilators.
8. Students are not allowed to leave early for any examination papers.
9. All books, notes and reference materials should be put in the place as instructed by the invigilators.
10. Students are not allowed to take away any examination materials, including multiple choice answer sheets, answer sheets, supplementary answer sheets or rough worksheets (both used or blank).
11. If found cheating, the student will receive zero marks for their paper and will be subject to disciplinary action.
12. After the "time is up" announcement is made, students must stop writing.
13. Students should raise their hand to draw the attention of the invigilators if they have a question or need any assistance.
14. Students can stay at home for revision if there is no examination scheduled for that day.
15. Students who have brought a mobile phone into the Examination Centre have to switch it off, including the alarm function, and put it under their chair in a position clearly visible to the invigilators. If a mobile phone emits sound during the examination, the student will be subject to a mark penalty.

d. Online Test/ Examination Guidelines for Cross-boundary Students

Students **must** prepare the following equipment before the test/ examination:

1. **At least 2 cameras:**

Camera 1 captures the face, hands of the student and the surface of the desk he/she is working on;
Camera 2 captures, from above, the surrounding desk area in the examination room the student is working in, including the screen of a mobile phone, tablet or desktop computer;

2. A mobile phone, tablet or desktop computer which must be equipped with a microphone and a speaker;
3. A charger;
4. A printer (for printing test papers);
5. Stationery.

If any of the above is missing, the student's answer script may not be graded.

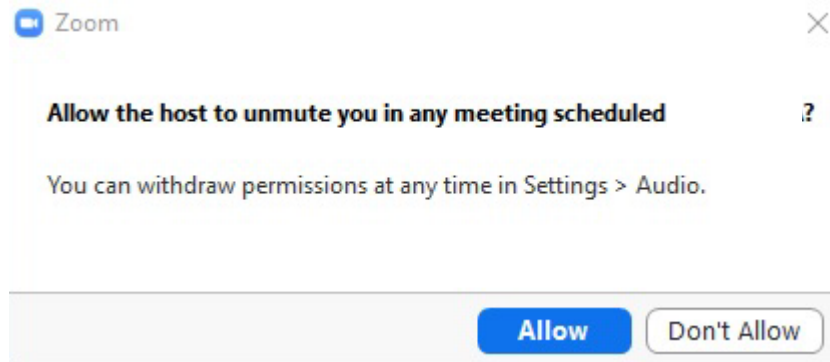
Before the test/ examination, students **must ensure** that:

1. the examination room is quiet;
2. the internet connection is stable;
3. the eClass password is valid. (If you have lost the password, please notify the school promptly);
4. the latest version of Zoom App has been installed in the mobile phone, tablet or desktop computer;
5. the App of creating PDF files has been installed in the mobile phone or tablet;

Online Test/ Examination Regulations

1. During the test/ examination, students are not allowed to use the virtual background. They must turn on two cameras, the speaker and the microphone throughout the whole process, to listen to and respond to the invigilator's instructions.
2. Apart from listening papers of Chinese Language, English Language and DSE Music, students are not allowed to wear earphones and use other electronic devices during the test/ examination. When the recording is finished, students must take off their earphones immediately.
3. During the test/ examination, students are not allowed to talk to anyone. Also, students must not look around and should focus on the paper test/ examination paper.
4. Leaving the seat during the test/ examination must be approved by the invigilator.
5. If students enter the Zoom Room late due to technical reasons, no make-up time will be given.

6. Before entering the Zoom Room, students must “Allow” the school to unmute them (see the picture below).

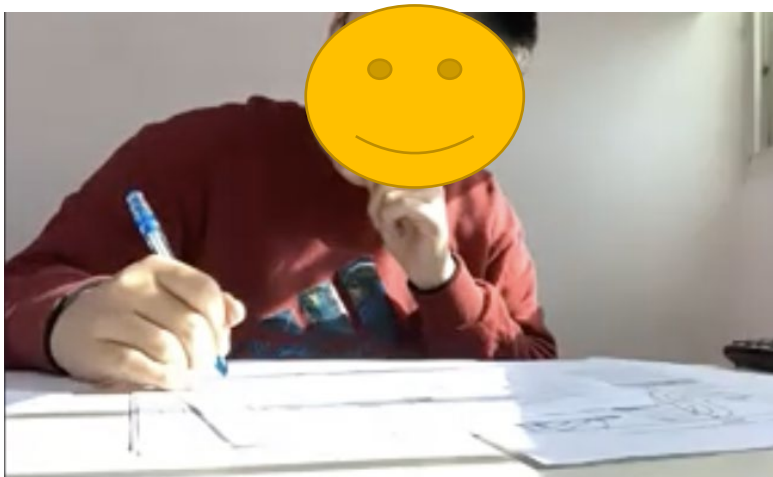


7. After entering the Zoom Room, students must sit properly and wait for the invigilator’s instructions. Otherwise, they will be subject to disciplinary action.
8. **Students are not allowed to turn off the camera when uploading or downloading test/ examination papers. At least one camera must be turned on to capture all ongoing activities.**
9. To ensure fairness, the whole test/ examination process will be videotaped. All video clips are used for the test/ examination only and will be destroyed six months after the test/ examination.
10. **Two cameras must capture the student’s face and hands, the surface of the desk as well as the surrounding desk area of the examination room throughout the test/ examination.** If any of the items cannot be viewed, a verbal warning will be given by the invigilator. If the situation does not improve after 3 verbal warnings, it will be treated as a serious violation of test/ examination regulations, and the answer scripts may not be graded.
11. Students need to ensure that the network is stable before taking the test/ examination. If the connection fails during the test/ examination, the answer scripts may not be graded. **When the student returns to the Zoom Room again, a private message must be sent to the invigilator in the Chatroom to explain the reason for the disconnection.** If no explanation is received, the student will be warned and the case will be treated as a serious violation of test / examination regulations.
12. Students must print out the test/ examination papers and upload the completed answer scripts. Only the **handwritten version** of the answer scripts will be accepted. Other forms of answer scripts may not be graded. **Students must submit their answer scripts by PowerLesson 2.** If they use other methods, they must give the school a reasonable explanation, otherwise their marks may be affected.
13. Students should upload the files in PDF format. Having checked the successful uploading of answer scripts and confirmed with the invigilator that the answer scripts have been received, students can then leave the Zoom Room.
14. Students must abide by ”Regulations for Examinations” on page 9 of the Student’s Handbook and Letter to Parents No.9.

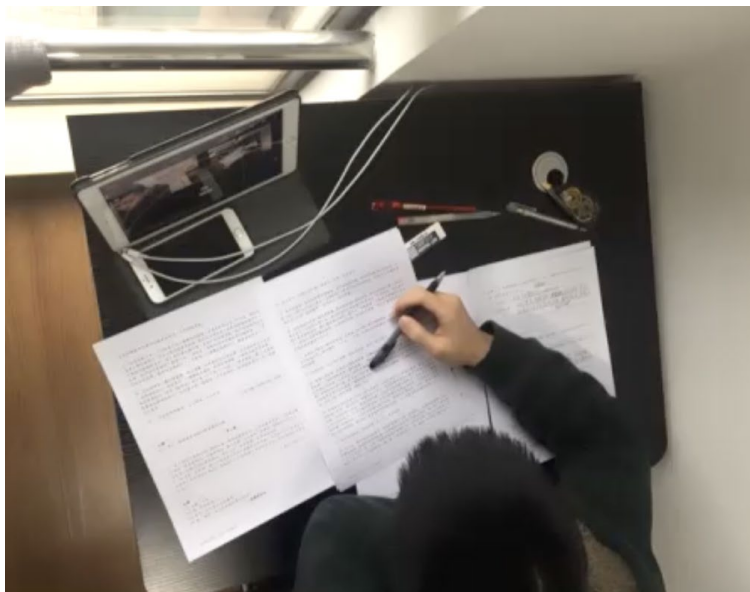
Rundown of Test/ Examination

1. Students should log in Zoom Room **15 minutes before the examination time**, for invigilators to check the positioning of the two cameras and for students to print test/ examination papers.
2. Question papers and answer sheets will be uploaded to PowerLesson 2 **10 minutes before the examination starts.**
3. Students can convert answer scripts to **PDF** files and upload to PowerLesson 2 within **10 minutes after the end of the examination.**

Camera 1: must capture the face and hands of the student as well as the surface of the desk the student is working on.



Camera 2: must capture, from above, the surrounding desk area of examination room the student is working in, including the screen of a mobile phone, tablet or desktop computer.

The Education Bureau (EDB) launched a one-stop website called "Smart Parent Net" to provide information on parent education (www.parent.edu.hk). The website enables parents with children from kindergarten to primary and secondary school levels to easily access useful information on supporting the physical and mental development of students, which includes the parent-child relationship, character development, parenting skills and emotional management of parents, with a view to promoting parent education.

To further enhance the support for parent education, the EDB will provide a wide range of information via "Smart Parent Net" to assist parents to master the knowledge and skills to nurture their children, encourage them to adopt positive education approaches, establish a good parent-child relationship and enhance children's resilience, so that children grow up healthily and happily.




"Smart Parent Net" provides video clips and articles on parent education shared by various academics and experts. Parents can also refer to important issues concerning them through the calendar on the webpage, for instance, parent education activities and the application methods, dates of making choices of schools for admission to Primary One or Secondary One and the release of central allocation results. In addition, parents can visit other related websites through the parent education directory. The content of "Smart Parent Net" will be updated regularly.

Parent Education Activity Information Hub on Smart Parent Net website

The Education Bureau (EDB) said that a new feature, Parent Education Activity Information Hub, has been set up on the parent education website Smart Parent Net. The Activity Information Hub provides parents of children in kindergarten, primary school and secondary school with one-stop access to information on parent education courses and activities so as to further enhance their knowledge and skills in parenting.

The Activity Information Hub provides various kinds of information on parent education courses and activities organised by different government bureaux and departments as well as post-secondary institutions in Hong Kong. The content will be updated regularly to let parents keep up with the latest information. Parents can filter activity information by using the category function, such as district, activity type, target participants and organiser, which can enable them to select suitable courses and activities. 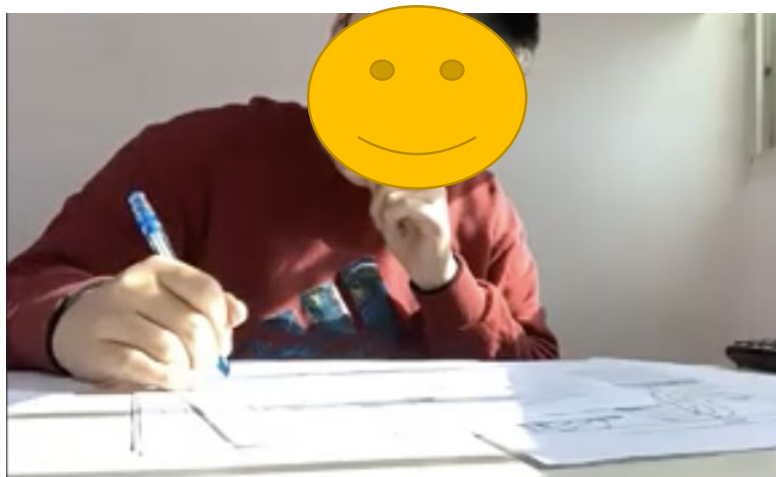

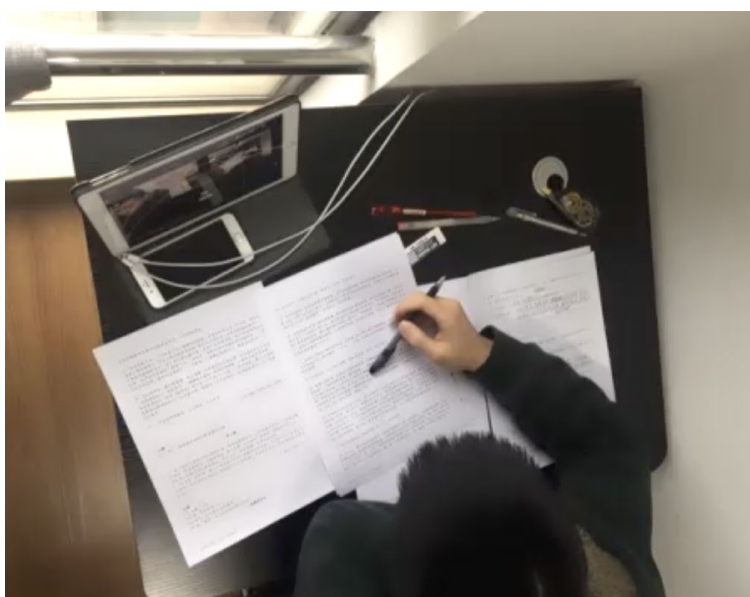
